> Illnesses are among the first unpleasant experiences with which children come in contact. The wise parent will see that his child learns something from this. The unwise one will hang over the child, pamper, and baby him.

Be truthful. Never fool your child about his illness, about pain, or in regard to food and medicine. If you tell him the medicine is not so bad, and he finds it is horrible to taste, he may lose some faith in

It is far better to tell him the medicine isn't pleasant, but he's getting to be a big boy now and you think that he can take it. He'll take pride in his accomplishment.

Make directions streamlined. Instructions should be simple, in as few words as possible. Be sure that they are necessary. Once given, see that they are obeyed. Be sure, for example, that Junior needs to stay in bed, and then insist that he stays there. We are inclined to give children too many or too rigid orders, and then allow too much leeway in their interpretation of those orders.


