





Firearms in the home always pose a danger for you and your loved ones. One of our horrible recollections of childhood was the occasion when a chum of ours--playing with a gun believed to be unloaded--blasted a young woman's arm off.

If you consider it necessary to have a weapon handy for protection, also consider the fact that thousands of human beings--young and old--are in their graves because someone was criminally negligent.

Guns, unfortunately, aren't the only dangerous objects that bring death to children in the home. Scissors and knives should be kept away from small children, as well as matches. This is easier said than done, but it's worth the effort.
