The three events which were held last Friday night all proved successful. The game which we played against the Kinston Red Devils was exciting and a victory for New Bern.

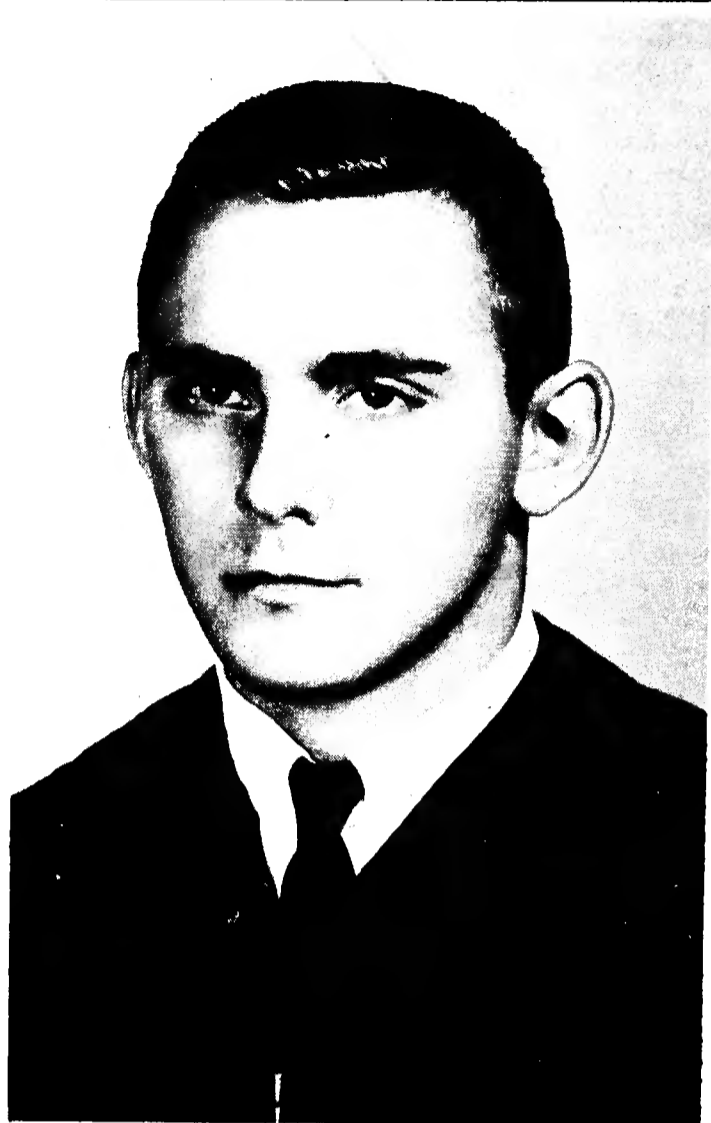

would have received even more publicity than they got. As it was, their names were emblazoned prominently on sports pages from coast to coast.

Higbe had a terrific season with the last place Phils. He led the National League in strikeouts, with 137, but also issued the most walks--121. The former Bruin was fifth in the loop among pitchers hardest to reach for home runs.

He gave up 11 in 283 innings, or one every 25.7 innings. He won 14 and lost 19 for a cellar club. Impressed, the Brooklyn Dodgers bought him at the end of the season for \$100,000 and three ball players. Incidentally, it proved to be a good invest-

ment.

This year's Northeastern Conference basketball tournament, opening Wednesday night at East Carolina College, should be one of the best. Although Kinston's Red Devils are favored, there are at least five clubs in the circuit capable of defeating Pat Taylor's quint. New Bern's unpredictable Bears might do the trick, if they are successful against other opponents.
