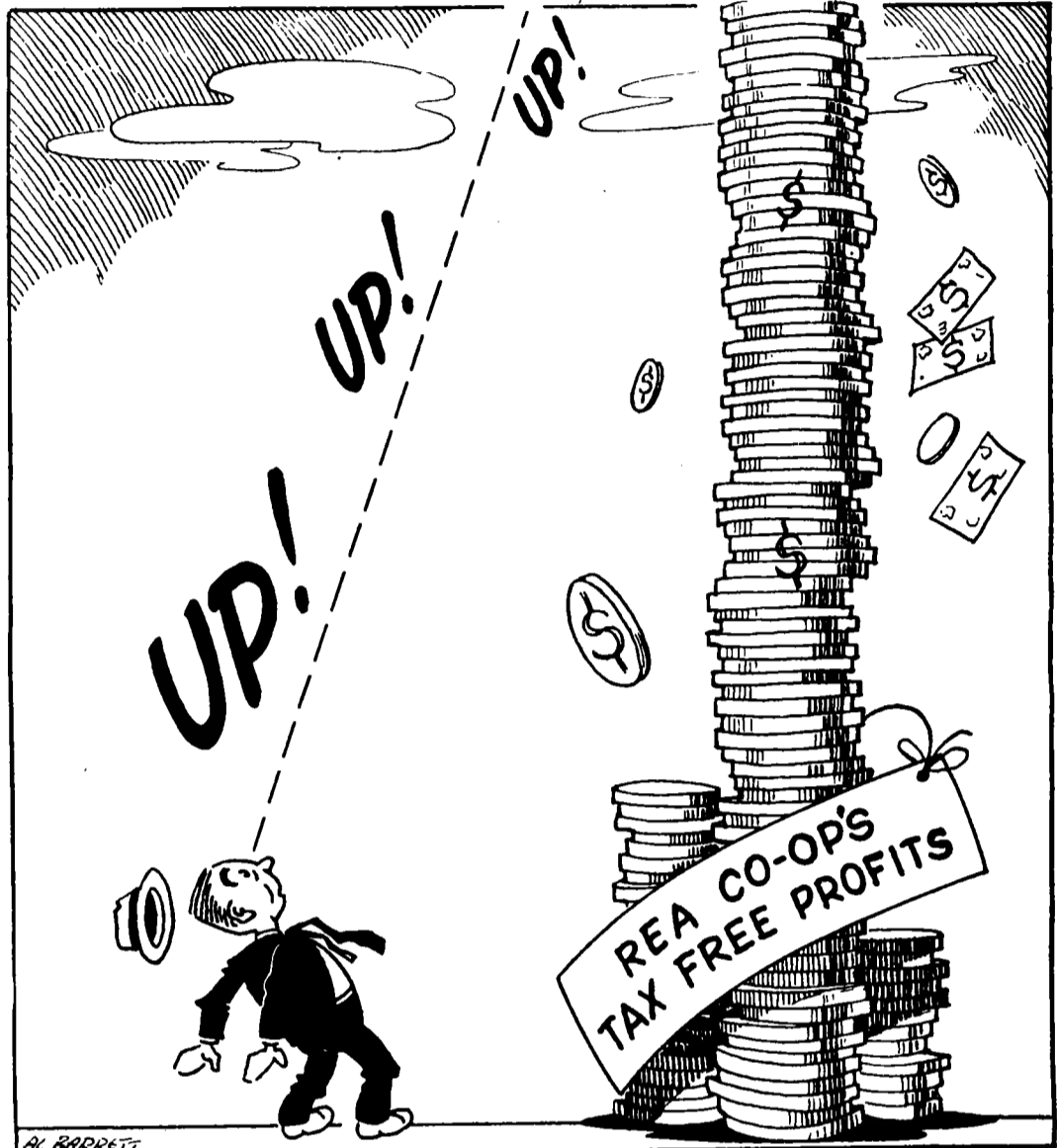

Rural electric co-ops in North Carolina had accumulated almost \$22 million in tax-free profits by the end of 1960, the latest year for which official statistics are available. These reports which REA co-ops made to Washington also show their "net margins" or profits are about \$3 million per year.

The stockpile of REA co-op profits is getting bigger every day at the expense of all taxpayers. It happens in two ways:

- 1) Electric co-ops borrow all their capital from the Federal government at 2 per cent interest . . . just about half of what the government is paying to borrow money.
- 2) They also are exempt from franchise, property and income taxes. So they make little or no contribution to support local, state and federal governments.

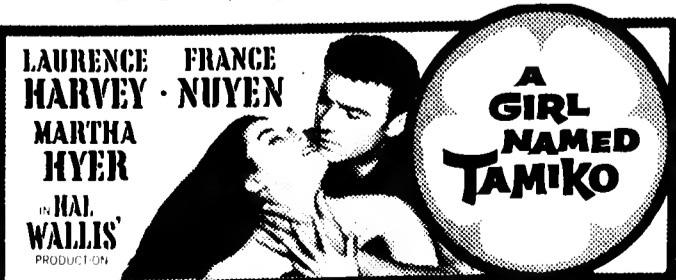
Does it seem *right* that all taxpaying citizens are required to keep on shouldering the bill for REA co-op subsidies while these co-ops are stockpiling big profits? And especially when you consider that the job for which they are subsidized--that is, extending electric service to rural areas that do not have it--is virtually complete.

Why not let your elected representatives know how you feel about this unneeded subsidy.
