Potato salad is a popular dish in mosi New Bern homes during the summer months. Although with your present reclpe, here's one that may strike your fancy. Ingredlents call for three cups of cold potatoes, cut in cubes; one teaspoon of salt; one tablespoon of chopped parsped celery; one-half tablespoon of chopped onion; sla radishes or two pimfentos, chopped; mayonnaise.
M1x potatoes, salt, celery, onlon, radishes (or pimiento) and parsley. Add enough mayonnalse to molsten. Place in
the refrigerator to absorb some of the dressing and to chill. Arrange on lettuce leaves to serve, and top with more mayonnalse.
This salad loaf has been recommended to us, so we'll pass the reclpe along to Mirror readers. You'll need one-foarth
