Whenever mention is made of Stan Musial and Hank Greenberg, two of baseball's all-time greats, we're reminded of their brothers, Ed and Joe respectively. Both played in the

Coastal Plain League, and performed against the New Bern Bears at Kafer Park here.

Although there have been a number of instances where brothers starred together in the Majors--brothers like the Deans, the Ferrels, and the Waners--Fayetteville's Ed Musial and Kinston's Joe Greenberg were doomed to spend their diamond days in minor league obscurity.

Stan The Man is still around, despite the fact that he was already a seasoned member of the St. Louis Cardinals when his brother Ed broke into organized ball with the Fayetteville Cubs in 1942.

New Bern fans who follow the Big Leagues via press, radio and television have probably forgotten that Stan started out with the St. Louis team as a pitcher. He was a good one too, but moved into the Cardinal outfield when he injured his arm.

Like the unforgettable Al Simmons of Philadelphia Athletics fame, who kept one foot in the bucket at the plate, Stan

Potato salad is a popular dish in most New Bern homes during the summer months. Although you're probably quite satisfied with your present recipe, here's one that may strike your fancy.

Ingredients call for three cups of cold potatoes, cut in cubes; one teaspoon of salt; one tablespoon of chopped parsley; three-fourths cup of chopped celery; one-half tablespoon of chopped onion; six radishes or two pimientos, chopped; mayonnaise.

Mix potatoes, salt, celery, onion, radishes (or pimiento) and parsley. Add enough mayonnaise to moisten. Place in the refrigerator to absorb some of the dressing and to chill. Arrange on lettuce leaves to serve, and top with more mayonnaise.

This salad loaf has been recommended to us, so we'll pass the recipe along to Mirror readers. You'll need one-fourth cup of vinegar; one-third cup of salad oil; one-fourth teaspoon of salt; pepper and paprika; three cups of chopped cooked turkey or chicken; two tablespoons of unflavored gelatin; one-half cup of cold water; two and a half cups of hot clear broth; two hard-cooked eggs,

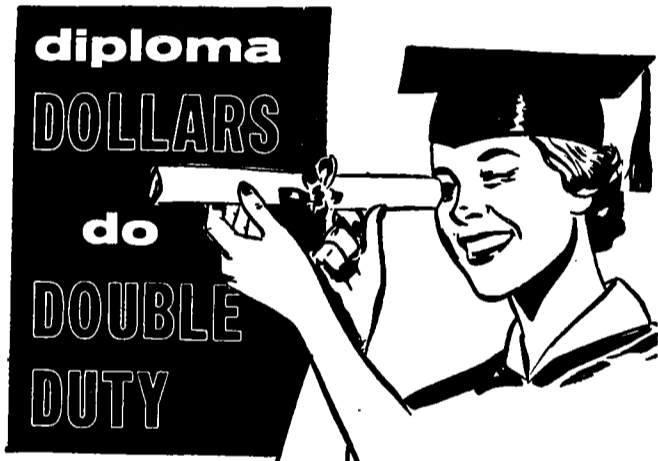
