There are seven pitchers on the East squad, so the local righthander will see only limited action. However, there is a possibility he may get into both ball games if the contests turn out to be scoring sprees.

Young Hardison is one of three Northeastern Conference stars chosen. Teaming with him are Kinston's Julian King, a third sacker who has an average of .417 for his four seasons with the Red Devils, and Jacksonville's Hank Crowson, an outfielder-pitcher with an impressive .333 batting average. Hardison can play outfield too.
