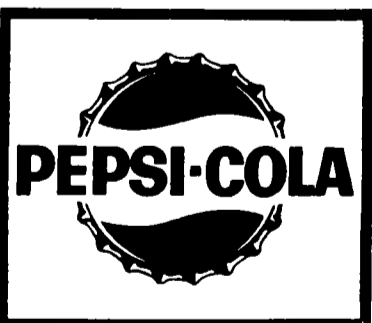

annual events as the Mountain Dance and Folk festival, the Southern Highland Handicraft Fair, and the Mountain Youth Jamboree. Throughout western North Carolina, folk music is as much a part of the scene as towering mountain peaks.
