



Almost every New Bern family welcomes seafood on the table at least once a week. For a change, try barbecued crab sandwiches.

You'll need one-half pound of crab meat; one-fourth cup of chopped onion; one-half cup of chopped celery; three tablespoons of butter or other fat melted; one-fourth teaspoon of salt; a dash of pepper; two whole bay leaves; two whole cloves; two teaspoons of soy sauce; two teaspoons of Worcestershire sauce; one chicken bouillon cube; one-half cup of tomato juice; two tablespoons of chopped parsley; and six large buttered rolls.

Remove any shell or cartilage from crab meat. Cook onion and celery in butter until tender. Add seasonings, bouillon cube, and tomato juice. Simmer for five minutes. Remove bay leaves and cloves. Add parsley and crab meat. Heat and serve on rolls.

For crab cakes, this recipe is delicious. You'll need one pound of crab meat; four tablespoons of melted butter; one-half teaspoon of salt; one-fourth teaspoon of black pepper; a pinch of cayenne pepper; two eggs, well beaten; fine bread crumbs; and cooking fat or oil.

Mix crab meat, butter, seasoning, and enough egg to mold into small cakes. Beat one tablespoon of water into the remaining egg and dip the cakes into this mixture. Roll in

crumbs. Saute' until rich brown in a heavy frying pan, or fry in deep fat at 380 degrees. Serve hot.

There are countless ways to serve crabs, such as crab meat salad, crab cocktail, sea ranch, crab bisque, spaghetti with crab sauce, crab potato cakes, crab ravigote, crab jambalaya, tomatoes stuffed with crab meat, Imperial crab, deviled crab, baked crab meat in shells, and crab Newburg.

TOT TALK



Although the average New Bern parent is aware that there are such things as child-labor laws, few of us are familiar with them.

The first Federal child-labor law, commonly known as the Keating-Owen Act, was adopted by Congress in 1916. It prohibited the interstate or foreign shipment of goods produced in factories, workshops, canneries, mines or quarries which employed children.

The Keating-Owen Act was declared unconstitutional in 1918. In 1919, Congress passed another law which had similar child-labor standards. It placed a 10 percent tax on the annual net profits of firms which employed children contrary to those standards.

In 1922, this law also was declared unconstitutional. Congress approved a constitutional amendment in 1924 which authorized Federal laws to regulate the employment of persons under 18 years of age. Only 28 states have approved this amendment.

The purposes of the amendment were partially achieved, however, by the adoption of the Federal Fair Labor Standards Act in 1938. This law sets a minimum age of 16 for employment in establishments producing goods for shipment in interstate or foreign commerce.

Limited employment of children in nonmanufacturing and nonmining occupations is permitted outside school hours for 14 and 15 year old children. A minimum age of 18 is required in occupations found and declared especially dangerous for minors by the Chief of the Children's Bureau.

Most states require employers of children under 16 to obtain work permits or employment certificates offering proof that they are of age, and that they have met all educational and other requirements.
