

There's a recipe for New Bern clam chowder included in "Seafood Cookery In North Carolina." The booklet was published jointly by the State Department of Conservation and Development and the Agricultural Extension Service at State

The recipe calls for three medium-sized potatoes, chopped; one quart of boiling water; one quart of clams chopped; one No. 2 can of tomatoes; three or four slices of salt pork; two onions, chopped; Worcestershire sauce; salt and pep-

water. Boil ten minutes. Add clams and tomatoes. Simmer ten minutes longer. Fry salt pork until crisp. Dice and add to chowder. Fry onions in pork drippings until golden, and add to chowder. Season with one to two tablespoons of Worcestershire sauce. Season to taste.

We hate to be disloyal to anything that carries a New Bern label, but deliver us from anybody's clam chowder that is ruined by adding tomatoes. We'll gladly settle for this recipe--Carterey County clam chowder, also in the booklet.

You'll need one quart of clams, chopped; two mediumsized potatoes, cubed; one medium-sized onion, chopped; one quart of water; salt and pepper; one-fourth pound of salf pork, cut in small cubes. Corn meal dumplings are suggested too, but why add them?

Fry pork until crisp and brown. Add potatoes, onions, clams and water. Simmer until potatoes are done, adding water to keep mixture from becoming too dry. Season to taste with salt and pepper. Cover tightly and simmer for fifteen minutes.

You'll have clam chowder at its best.
