colonies, so they make a beautiful display in the garden. The foliage appears in early spring, but they bloom in the fall without foliage. Plant them beneath ground covers for a perfect setting for their long slender

Cut your flowers early in the morning for prettier arrangements. Slant the stem when you cut them, as this gives them the advantage of more water intake. Remove all leaves that would be beneath the water, as these decay and cause bacteria

Poppies, dahlias, and lautona have to have the ends seared, but woody stems have to have the ends cut vertically several times to be able to drink water. Keep all flowers from drafts. change the water each day, and don't keep in sunlight and heat.
