Try this recipe for peanut butter chiffon pie. If you don't fancy it, the kids will eat your share.

You'll need 1 envelope of plain gelatin; I cup of cold water; 2 egg yolks, well beaten; 1/4 cup of sugar or light corn syrup; 1/2 teaspoon of salt; 1/2 cup of peanut butter; 2 egg whites; 1/2 teaspoon of vanilla; 19-inch baked pie shell.

Soften gelatin in 1/4 cup of cold water. Blend egg yolks, 1/2 of the sugar, 1/4 cup of water, and salt in the top of a double boiler. Beat with a rotary

beater until thick and fluffy.

Place the peanut butter in bowl, add remaining water gradually, beating until smooth. Add egg mixture and vanilla, blend with beater. Chill until slightly thickened. Beat whites foamy--add remaining sugar, beating until stiff.

Fold in chilled mixture. Turn into ple shell (or crumb crust) and chill. Top with sweetened whipped cream and chopped
