Start mulching your acid plants. Summer is the season for preparation for a beautiful spring.

Plants are filled with sap in the morning, so cut most flowers then. Late afternoon is a good time to cut flowers with hollow stems.

Never crowd flowers in a small-mouth container. Burn ends of plants having sticky, milky sap.

Put sulphur on arms, legs, or on grass, to keep chiggers away. Spray perennials subject to milkdew. Dust roses each week until frost.

Plant delphiniums for a real treat in your garden. They come from Siberia. They originated in shades of blue and purple. Be careful cultivating around the plants.
