

Snowman Adds Cheery Note To 'Do-It-Yourself' Decorating Ideas

Christmas and snowmen go together—but what if it doesn't snow? Mom and/or the kids can make a decorative snowman that doesn't melt, and doesn't need snow — just gift wrapping materials.

Here's all that's needed:
 3 rolls white "Lustre-Tie" 1 1/4" ribbon
 1 roll scarlet 3/4" ribbon
 2 foam balls — 3" for head, 5" for body
 Pipe cleaners, pins, heads, cardboard, 8 1/2" dowel, paper cup and gift wrap
 Strip white ribbon into three parts and wind around each foam ball. Cut white ribbon into four-inch lengths; using pin, finely slash centers, leaving one-half inch margins at each end, which will be moistened and stuck together to form fringe.

Starting at bottom of foam balls, moisten fringes and stick to ribbon base, working in overlapping rows. Attach head to body with a toothpick and add scarlet ribbon bow. Pin on bead eyes.

Make arms by winding fringe around pipe cleaners; insert into body. Cover a paper cup and a cardboard circle

with gift wrap and glue together for hat. Pin to head.

Shred eight three-inch strips of scarlet ribbon and wind around one end of dowel for broom; cover remainder of dowel with red ribbon.
