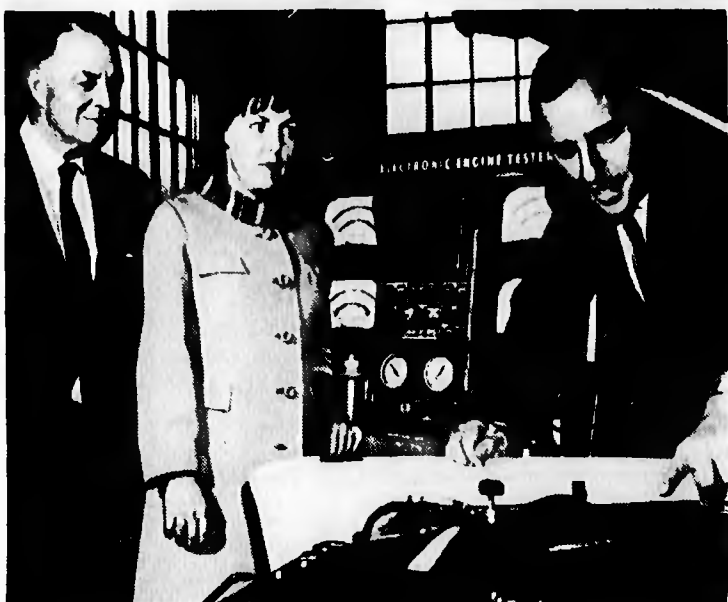

When you shop for a coffee maker look for these signs of quality:

A handle you can grasp firmly and safely.

Safe, easy pouring.

A solid base, broad enough to prevent tipping.

Easy to clean, smooth surfaces with a minimum of seams, crevices and tubes.

(Remember you can scour metals, but you must use special stain removers for plated linings.)

Parts that can be easily replaced if lost or damaged.

Clear use-and-care directions.

Automatic models should have: A signal light or glass

top to show when brewing is finished; a well-insulated base to protect the surface it stands on; immersibility; and a keep-warm setting.

There are also innumerable other convenience features available percolators. Evaluate them in terms of real convenience and how they might help brew a better cup of coffee.

Whatever choice you make read the instruction book and follow manufacturers recommendation for best results.
