For the two, father and son,

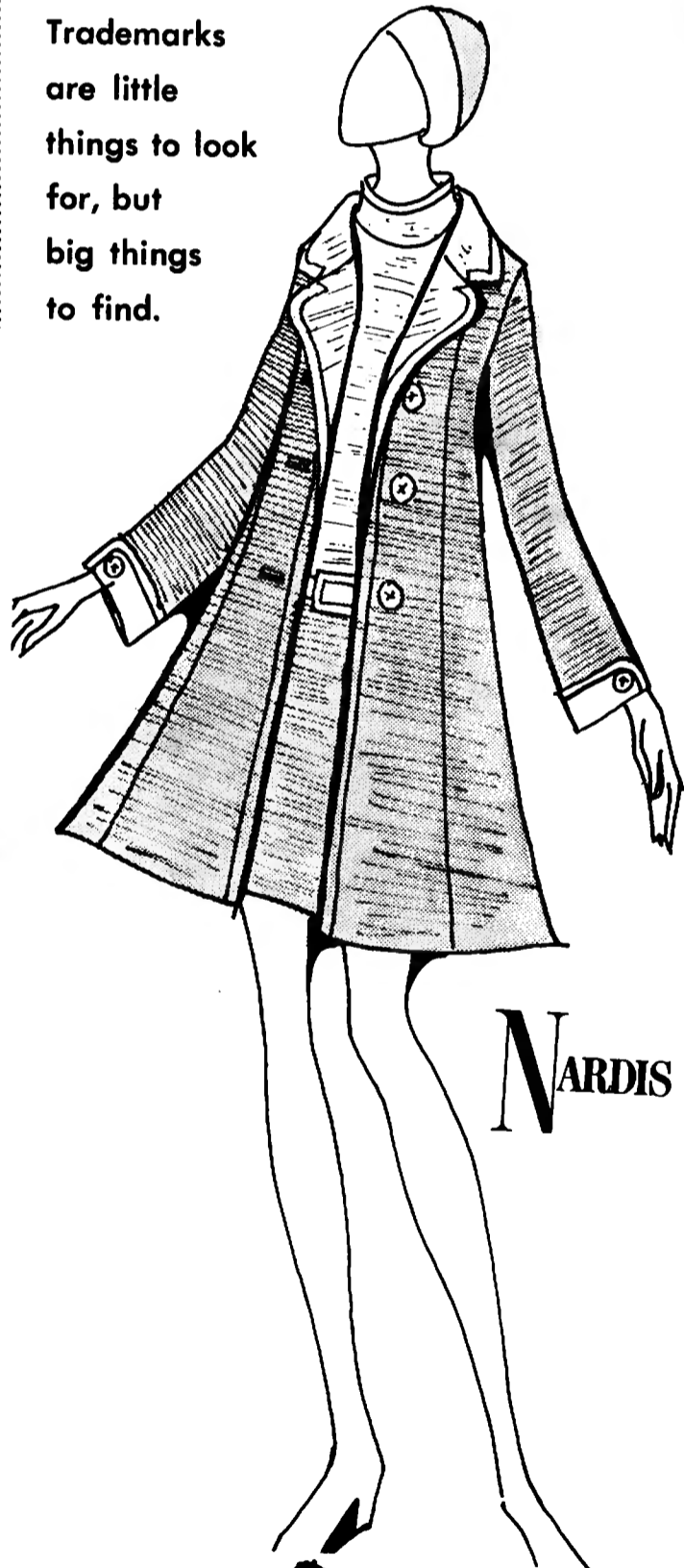
