**Butteric & Simplicity** Patterns and all




The ever-growing problem of drugs has become one of major importance. No longer is it confined to the big cities, but has spread to practically every area of this country. Unfortunately, recent statistics show that young teen-agers are the most likely victims.

Last week in an effort to combat this menace, the House passed legislation, H. R. 12089, which would establish the Special Action Office for Drug Abuse Prevention. This will bring under one department a co-ordination of efforts now being exercised by several. as was stated during the debate, "We can no longer afford the luxury of having each Federal agency respond to one part of the drug problem without linking its efforts to others underway." Perhaps the intent of the bill can best be expressed by langugage contained in the subtitle, "It is the policy of the United States and the purpose of



this Act to focus the resources on the Federal Government and bring them to bear on drug abuse to significiantly reduce the incidence of drug addiction and drug abuse in the U. S. within the shortest practicable period of time and to develop a comprehensive coordinated long-term Federal strategy to combat drug abuse."

A heated controversy arose as a result of Congressman Teague, Chairman of the Veterans Affairs Committee, attempting to remove the VA hospitals from the authority and control of the Special Office for Drug Aubse and Prevention. He contended that the VA had special problems as it related to military personnel and should be free to combat the drug problem with their own methods and procedures. Although his amendment was rejected 196 to 174, along with Congressmen Fountain, Jen-
