of things you don't expect too." Now is a good time to put out edgings for your borders. Pachysandra, or Japanese spurge is an excellent plant for this. It stays all winter as it is in summer. Hosta or plantain plants make excellent summer plants, but do not remain in

foliage in winter. Use plenty of gray plants, such as lamb's ear, lavender, silver king, and dusty miller in your border for contrast. You may plant them now.

Some gardeners use pine straw, or bark, around trees in the yard. You may use ground cover equally as well, and it is real pretty.

Feed roses and mums. Keep plenty of water for them. They will pay you in blossoms for your effort.


