## Rotary hears Stewart

Vanceboro, the Craven County Council on the Aged, spoke to the its regular Thursday night programs for the aged in Craven County and to seek ways of replacing tax-supported programs with volunteer and self-supporting programs. The Council has as one of its chief projects "Meals on Wheels" in which volunteers deliver one balanced meal per day to ten elderly persons in New Bern. The recipients pay \$1.50 per meal when they can. Meals on Wheels is backed by a \$5,000 grant from the Craven County Board of Commissioners.

A long range goal of the Council for the Aged is the construction of a Multi-Purpose Senior Citizens Center. This center would serve as a focal point for the aged in areas of recreation, education, and basic services. It would allow space for other agencies which serve the aged such as the Health Department, Social Services, and the Food Stamp Program. The center could also house an adult day care center which would allow working families to keep their loved
