MEDICINE CHEST

Is digitalis effective for weight reduction? — F.P.
This drug had been used in the past for weight reduction. The government has required drug manufacturers of these products to warn physicians and pharmacists of the dangers of using these products for weight reduction. The new warning indicates that they are not effective as a weight reducer. Moreover, they may cause potentially fatal irregular heart beats or other adverse effects.

Is there any drug available for dissolving kidney stones? — T.P.

Unfortunately there is nothing available that you can swallow and dissolve kidney stones. A chemical referred to as EDTA has been used to irrigate the tubes leading to the kidneys, and has been effective in dissolving stones located in the tubes. This irrigation procedure (catheterization) can be painful, cause complication such as infections, and take a long time to accomplish while hospitalized. Hopefully, research oriented drug companies will develop an effective medicine for this condition.

How can birth marks be removed? — S.H.

Birth marks have been treated with surgery, skin grafts, freezing and injections. The latest method is like something out of Star Wars. It's an Argon Laser Device. The laser beam "bleaches out" the birth mark and with no apparent adverse effects.

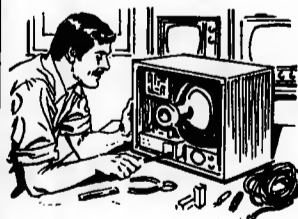
