The bride-elect was presented a long stem red rose and the mothers of the bride and bridegroom were presented with corsages of carnations by the hostesses.

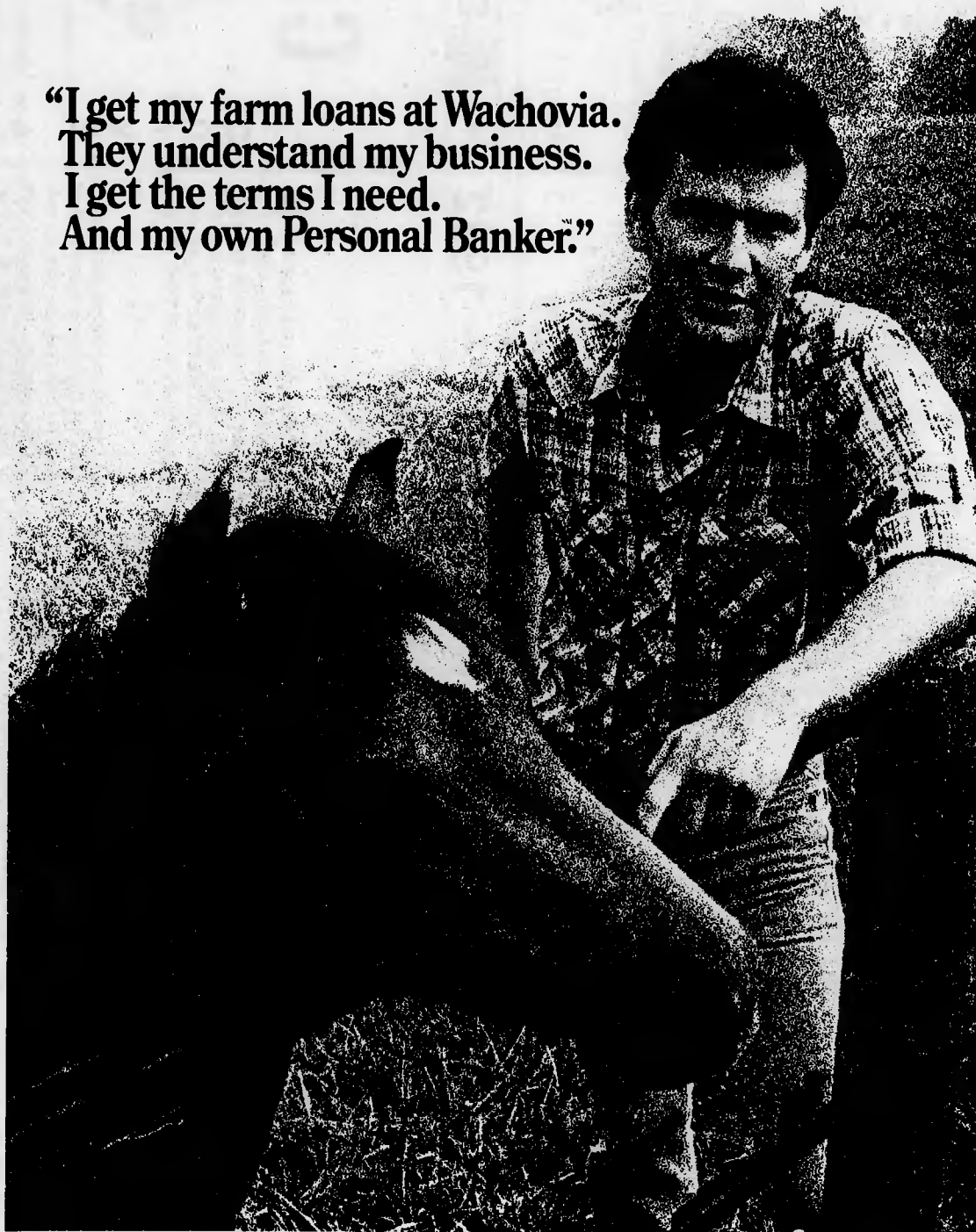
The bride-elect was presented with gifts by the hostesses and twenty-five guests.
