Lane L. Collins of Neuse Mental Health Center spoke April 14 and 17 on Epilepsy which is a disorder of certain nerve cells in the brain. There are three chief types of epileptic attacks:

- (1) Grand Mal, (2) Petit Mal, and (3) Psychomotor.

In a grand mal attack, the most severe type of epileptic seizure, the victim suddenly loses consciousness. The person falls, and muscles jerk. It usually lasts a few minutes after which the person goes into a deep sleep.

During a petit mal attack, a mild type of seizure the victim loses awareness of his or her surroundings for only a few seconds.

In a psychomotor attack, the patient acts withdrawn and behaves strangely for a few minutes.

A message inside the invitation describes how cystic fibrosis affects its victims and how this genetic disease is transmitted.

Cystic fibrosis is an inherited, fatal lung and digestive disease that takes the lives of half its victims before they reach their twenties. It is called the number one genetic killer of children and young adults in the United States. The Cystic Fibrosis Foundation uses funds raised through projects like the Mother's Day Tea to support its research, treatment and patient care programs in North Carolina and nationwide.

In North Carolina there are two Cystic Fibrosis Centers: at UNC School of Medicine in Chapel Hill and Duke Medical Center in Durham.
