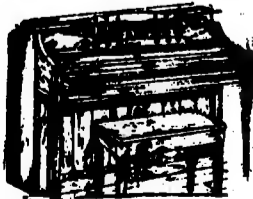
So far, our longest-lived president was John Adams, who lived to be nearly 91 years old.
