## COOKING ${ }^{\text {menemu }}$

In a previous article, I had a recipe for sour dough bread and the starter. Shortly after I was given a recipe for Herman Cake.

1 cup starter
2 eggs
2/3 cup oil
$11 / 2$ tsp. cinnamon
1 cup sugar
2 cups plain flour
$1 / 2$ tsp. salt
2 tsp. baking powder
$11 / 2$ tsp. baking soda 1 cup chopped nuts 1 cup raisins 1 cup coconut (if desired)

Mix at medium speed. Pour into greased and floured pan ( $13^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{\prime \prime}$ ) or 2 -( $8^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$ pans).

I discovered the same starter is used for the cake as for the bread.

Due to requests, I am now presenting the recipe for Herman Cake.
HERMAN CAKE
Sprinkle with topping. Bake at 360 degrees for 30 to 45 minutes. Glaze while hot.

TOPPING
1 tbsp. flour
1 cup brown sugar
1 tbsp. cinnamon $1 / 2$ cup margarine

Mix until crumbly
GLAZE
1 cup confectioners sugar
2 tbsp. milk
2 tbsp. margarine
