The minutes were read and approved and the Chapter closed in regular form.

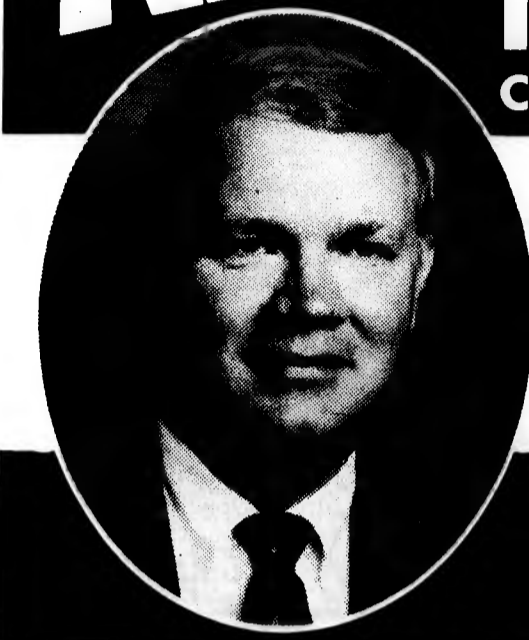
