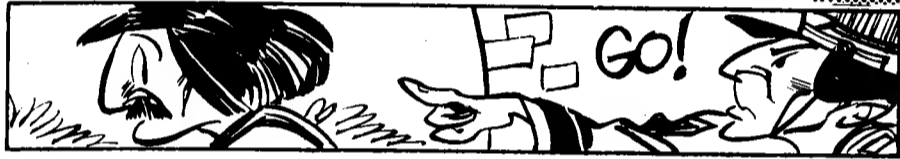
One hundred twenty three East Carolina University teacher education students have been assigned practice teaching in North Carolina public schools this semester.
