1 (8 oz.) jar cherries, drained 1 lb. dates (3 cups) 4 eggs

Sift flour with sugar, salt and baking powder in large bowl. Add dates, nuts, and cherries. Mix thoroughly with flour mixture. In another bowl, beat 3 bananas and eggs until light and fluffy. Fold in flour mixture. Bake in tube pan at 350 degrees until cake tests done - about 2 hrs. Frost with powdered sugar icing. Decorate with candied cherries and nuts, or as desired.
