The state sales tax will not be an additional charge because the 1984 N.C. General Assembly made a similar reduction in the gross receipts tax included in utility rates. Both the

addition of the sales tax and the corresponding reduction of the gross receipts tax will take effect on January 1.

The stated reason for the change is to enable individuals who itemize their deductions on their federal income tax returns to claim the sales tax paid as a deduction.
