

School Record Set Second Meet

Sophomore Derek Booker broke the West Craven High School Record in the 200 meter dash at home versus D.H. Conley. Booker led the team with 13 points as the boys went on to win the meet.

Booker's time of 22.17 in the 200 meter dash broke the school record set by David Taylor (22.37) in 1985. The previous record a 1980 time of 23.97 by Rufus Harris.

Booker also won the 100 meter dash (11.06), and was second (21'7") in the long jump to Jesse Campbell. Campbell won the long jump with a leap of 22; and he won the high jump with a 6'4" jump.

Arnord Moore won the triple jump with a leap of 42'10", and he was second in the 100 meter (11.6) and 200 meter (24.2). Pernell Kornegay won the 300 meter hurdles and tied for second in the high jump (6'). Linwood Gaskins was second in the 400 meter dash (58.9) and the 110 meter high hurdles. Lee Woolard won the 1600 meter run (5.15) and was third in the 800 meter. Sophomore Stevie Harris was third in the long jump (21'5"), and he tied for second in the high jump (6').

Other points were tallied by Joe Squires (second in triple jump), Terrill Hardy (Second in

shot put), Miguel Bryant (second in 300 meter hurdles), sophomore Tony Dawson (third in 400 meter dash), Jason Ailen (third in discus), and Melvin Couell (third in 100 meter.)

The girls team was lead by Anissa Scott who won the shot put (30'7") and discus (82'2"), and was third in the long jump (13'3") Theresa Dillahunt had first (long jump 15'3"), second (200 meter-.29), and third place (high jump - 4'8") finishes. Jewel White had her best meet by winning the 400 meter dash and by finishing second in the discus (66'7") and third in the shot put (22'1"). Patricia Bryant was second in the high jump (4'9" and third in the 100 meter dash (13.09). Winning the triple jump (27') was Monica Scott. Amanda Faulkner was second in the 3200 meter run (15:30) and third in the discus.

Leslie Cox was third in the 200 meter dash, and Lynnell West ran the mile in 7:10. Charlene Jackson ran with Monica Scott, Dillahunt, and Bryant on the 400 relay team, that finished first (56.4).

The track teams have two meets a week, as they prepare for the Coastal 3-A Track on Thursday May 1 at Havelock High School.

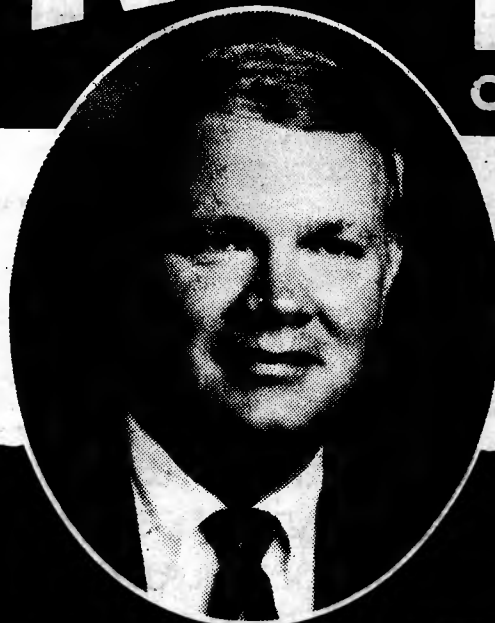
