Dedication Ceremony Set For US-321 In Boone Highway To Be Named For Governor Holshouser

RALEIGH--Former Governor James E. Holshouser, Jr. will be honored during an April 29 ceremony to dedicate Us-321 in Boone.

Governor Jim Martin and North Carolina Transportation Secretary James E. Harrington will attend the dedication ceremony at 11 a.m. when the highway will officially be named "The James E. Holshouser, Jr. Highway." The ceremony will take place on US-321, approximately .04 miles from the Boone City line.

Harrington noted, "James E. Holshouser has provided the state of North Carolina with excellent leadership. In appreciation to the Watauga County native for his efforts to

improve the quality of life in North Carolina, our state Board of Transportation adopted a resolution on November 8, 1985 to name the highway in his honor."

Initial construction of US-321 started in March, 1977, with completion following in November, 1982. The highway is approximately 5.3 miles long and runs from Boone to NC-105 in Blowing Rock.

Sharing the platform with former Governor Holshouser, Secretary Harrington and Governor Martin will be Holshouser family members, Boone Mayor Larry Keeter and other state, local and federal officials. The public is invited to attend.
