

Segal Injured

Raleigh, N.C. Sept. 16, 1986-
-Due to extensive injuries he suffered in an accident last month, Jonathan M. Segal of Gastonia has resigned the presidency of the North Carolina Press Association.

Segal, publisher of *The Gastonia Gazette*, was struck by a motorcycle Aug. 28 as he examined his dog that had been hit by a car. He is hospitalized in Gaston County, recovering from multiple fractures and internal injuries.

NCPA Vice President Cari Worsley has stepped in as president to finish Segal's term. The term will expire July 21, 1897.

Worsley is publisher of *The Evening and Sunday Telegram* in Rocky Mount, a post he has held since 1970.

He began working as an advertising salesman at The Telegram after his graduation from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. He has served as president of the Rocky Mount Merchant's Association, as a director of the *National Newspaper Advertising Group*, and as a director and president of the *Mid-Atlantic Newspaper and Marketing Executives*. He was on the NCPA Board of Directors from 1981-1983.

Worsley and his wife, Nancy, have three children, Carl E. Worsley, Jr., Ruth Esther Griffin, and Frances Lee Worsley, all of Rocky Mount.

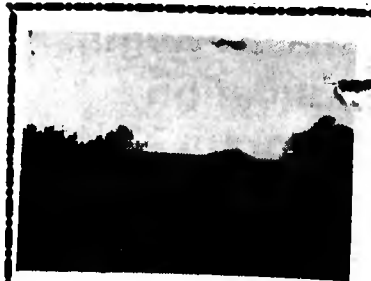
Wilcox, Sutton to marry

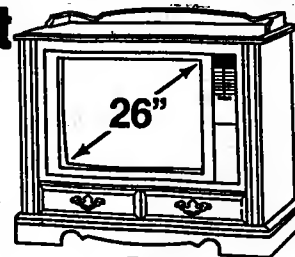
