The duties of the marshals include taking up the offering in chapel, leading chapel lines, acting as ushers in the auditorium, and maintaining order in all student gatherings. The new marshals will assume their duties on the third Sunday before commencement.

Erwin Parrott, the Chief-Marshall, has been at St. Mary's for three years. During her freshman year she was elected dance marshal from her class and has been re-elected every year. She is an Orchestras member and was also a Beacon member. Jackie Baublitz and Winston Conner also attended high school at St. Mary's.
