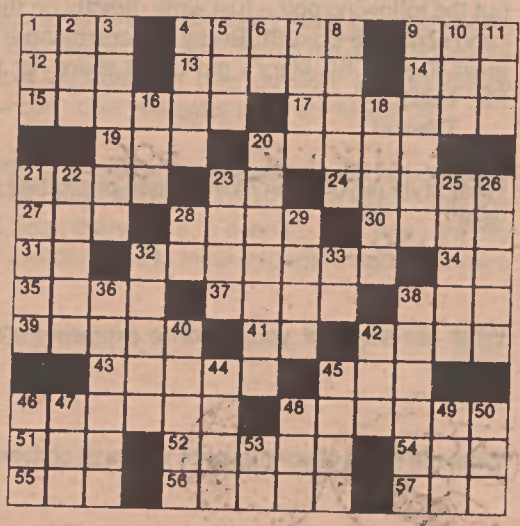

An exhibition organized by the National Ornamental Metals Museum of Memphis and circulated by the Southern Arts Federation traces the development of the use of cast iron and forged steel in making jewelry. Selected examples of jewelry from eighteenth century Berlin, to chiselling and engraving from nineteenth century England to contemporary methods in America will be exhibited.

Co-sponsored by the North Carolina Japan Center, this is an exhibition of folk arts assembled by Patricia Massy, a foremost expert in Japan in subjects of crafts. Ms. Massy will bring representative art by the folk artist, artisan and designer artist without preference of craftsman. Ms. Massy writes an illustrated monthly column for the JAPAN TIMES and lectures extensively in Japan.

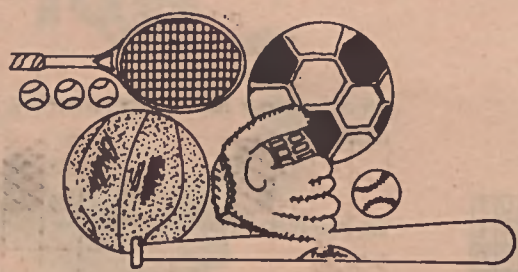
