The Correspondence School is for those who cannot attend the Institute in person. Eight Courses are offered in different methods of Bible Study, Practical Christian Work, Evangelism, Christian Evidences, etc. For these a limited fee is charged. The enrollmnt last year was 10,047.

EXTENSION DEPARTMENT

This Department Supplies Bible Teachers, Evangelists and Gospel Singers for the church and mission work, and also conducts Bible Conferences, Music Classes and Evangelistic Meetings wherever call-
