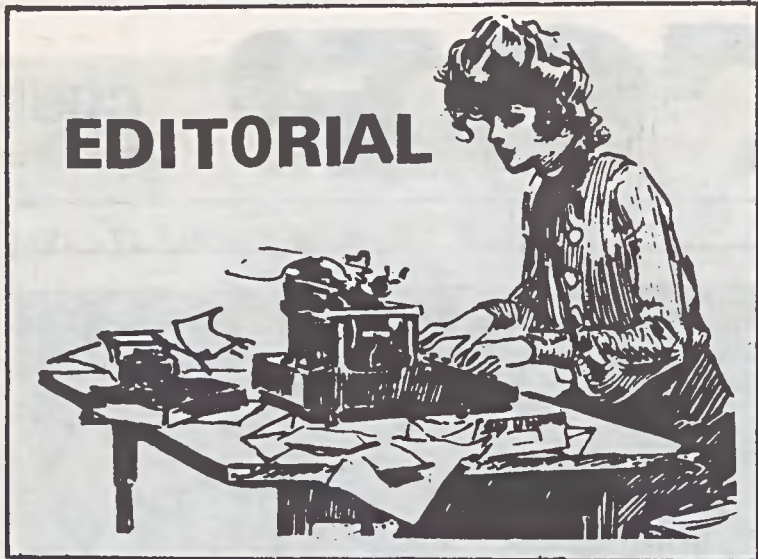


# EDITORIAL

Yes ma'am, I quit that job. It was the most ridiculous place I've ever been in!

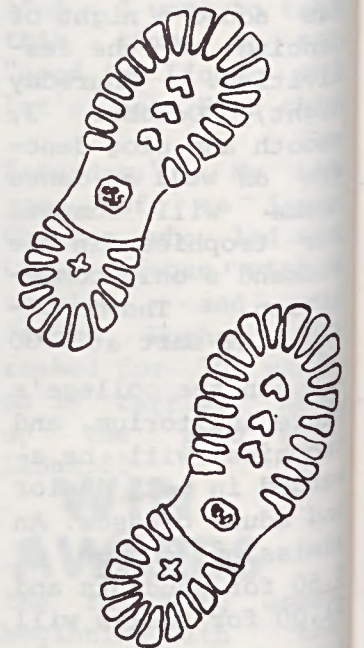
