## MAN DEAD 10 DAYS FOUND AT WELDON NEAR RIVER BANK

The badly decomposed body of a
man, tentatively
identified as Kan, tentatively lientified as was discovered suspended from the low limb of a tree about 30 -yards from the banks of the Roanoke River in the dense undergrowth between the railroad bridges near Weldon by two small boys in swimming about $3: 30$ this afternoon. The man had evidently been dead for 10-days, or more. Dressed in expensive clothes, over $\$ 300$ in U.S. currency and a substantial sum of Norwegian money was found in a coat which was discarded about 20 -
feet from the body. feet from the body.
Authorities are definitely puzzled
over the finding of the body as over the finding of the body as of foul play, despiter signs of blood on the coat, and the large sum of money would tend to discount any theory of robbery. The position of the body tends to discredit the theory he could have committed suicide by hanging himself.

ALLSBROOK NOT TO CONTEST ALTHO CITIZENS REPORT WHOLESALE CORRUPTION AND BEG FOR RECOUNT
