# **Northampton** Co. Children

About 115 pupils from the schools of Northampton County were Xrayed for tuberculosis at the Roanoke Rapids Hospital Wednesday of this week. Reports on the pictures will be in the hands of the Northampton County Health Department in about three weeks, it

The children were brought to the hospital as a result of tuberculin tests given last November, the children receiving positive reactions disease.

Wednesday of this week was set for the colored children of Northampton, but the snow necessitated a postponement of plans.

The clinic was in charge of Dr. Parker, Northampton County health officer. He was assisted by technicians from the state sanitorium, Harold Satterthwaite and Harry Timberlake, the latter formerly of Northampton County. County nurses, Misses Idell Buchan and Hilda Caviness, assisted in the clinic also.

In an interview Miss Buchan said that 115 positive reactions among the total number of children in the schools of the county is about an average percentage. She said that no one is able to predict the number that will have tuberculosis out of a group of children who react to the tuberculin tests.
