CREDIT GROUP HAS MEETING IN WELDON SAT.

Plans For Year Talked At Meet.

The importance of agriculture in the present world-wide emergency and plans for financing changed farming operations resulting from the defense program were emphasized to stockholders of the Weldon Production Credit Association in annual meeting at the high school building here Saturday morning. Reports covering the association's operations during the past year were also presented and two directors were elected. farmers from Northampton and Halifax counties attended this meeting.

W. E. Smith, president of the association, presided and in opening the meeting he called upon those present to think seriously of "the challenge to our freedom and the important part we can play in the struggle for victory." He pointed out that the Weldon association, like the other 524 production credit associations throughout the country, would adapt its service to changing conditions with the view of being of the most possible aid in helping to meet the need for additional credit for production and general agricultural purposes.

Reports given by B. N. Capel, secretary-treasurer, indicated that during 1941 the association made loans in the amount of \$484,128.00 to 485 members. Mr. Capel stated that members now own \$27,785.00 in capital stock and that accumulated reserves amount to \$33,403.00.

J. R. Jackson, representative of the Production Credit Corporation, which supervises production credit associations in North Carolina, South Carolina, Georgia, and Florida, addressed the group briefly. He referred to the production credit association as "the farmer's own credit institution, standing


