At this hearing, general information will also be presented on the plan for the comprehensive development of the water resources of the Roanoke River Basin.

Authority for the construction of the Buggs Island project is provided for in Public Law 534 - 78th Congress, 2nd Session, approved 22 December, 1944.

All interested parties are invited to attend the hearing, particularly those parties interested in the development of the water resources of the Roanoke River Basin, and officials of states, counties, cities, towns, and local associations whose interests may be affected. Those attending the hearing will be given an opportunity to express their views regarding the improvements under consideration.

Oral statements will be heard; but for the accuracy of the record, all important facts and arguments should be submitted in writing, in quadruplicate. Written statements may be handed in at the hearing but preferably should be mailed to reach the District Engineer at least three days prior to the hearing.
