In order to give as many girls and boys as possible the advantage of this excellent training, parents, friends and all civic, patriotic, fraternal, literary and school organizations are invited to sponsor eligible youths of their selection. The application for each must be signed by the superintendent or principal of their school and approved by the president of the nearest unit of the American Legion Auxiliary.

Girls' State will open on Sunday, June 11, and will close on Friday morning, June 16, at Woman's College. Boys' State will be held at the University of North Carolina in Chapel Hill.
