N.C. Black Rep, Charlotte Rep Collaborate To Present *Fences*

The Charlotte Repertory Company, a professional white theatre in the City of Charlotte, and the North Carolina Black Repertory Company, a professional black theatre based in the City of Winston-Salem have formed a partnership to produce the first professional production in the State of North Carolina of the Pulitzer Prize winning Broadway hit drama, *FENCES*, by award winning African-Ameri-

can playwright, August Wilson, March 15, 16, 22, 23, 29 and 30 at 8 p.m. and March 17, 24, and 31 at 3 p.m. in the Arts Council Theatre, 610 Coliseum Drive, Winston-Salem.

Directed by Larry Leon Hamlin, artistic director of the North Carolina Black Repertory Company, and produced by Mark Woods, artistic director of the Charlotte Repertory Theatre, *FENCES* opened in Charlotte on

February 13th to excellent reviews. The play will continue its run in Charlotte through March 9, and will open in Winston-Salem on March 15.

FENCES, is the story of Troy Maxson, born to a sharecropper father who is frustrated by the fact that every crop took him further into debt. The father knew himself as a failure and took it out on everyone at hand, including his young son, Troy.
