We are happy to welcome a new student, Betty Jean Dunston, of Montclair, New Jersey.

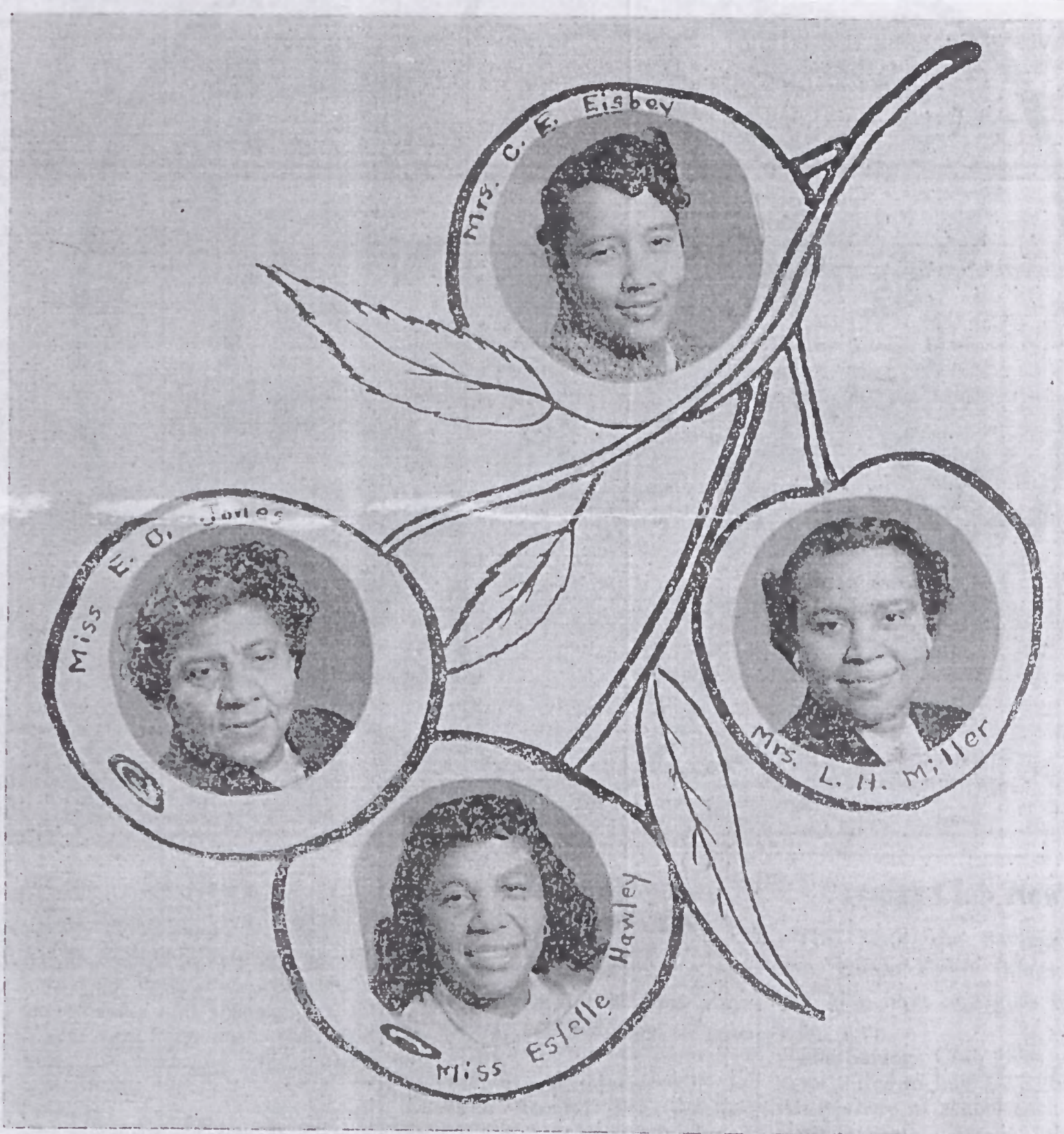
