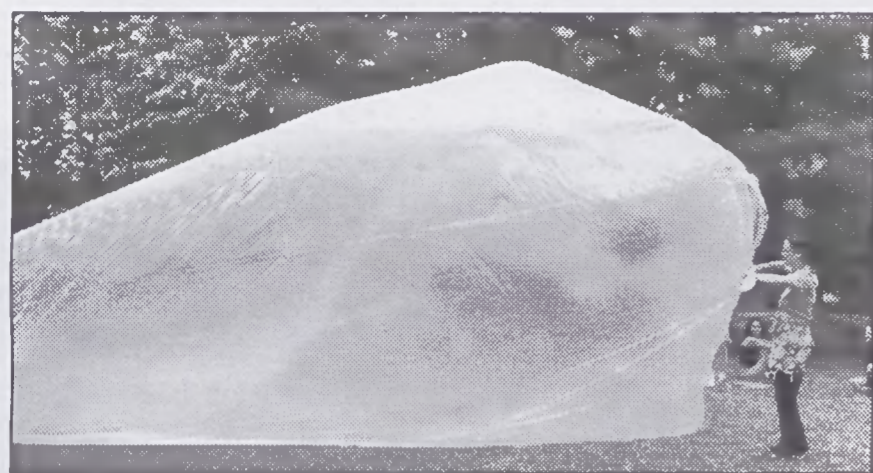


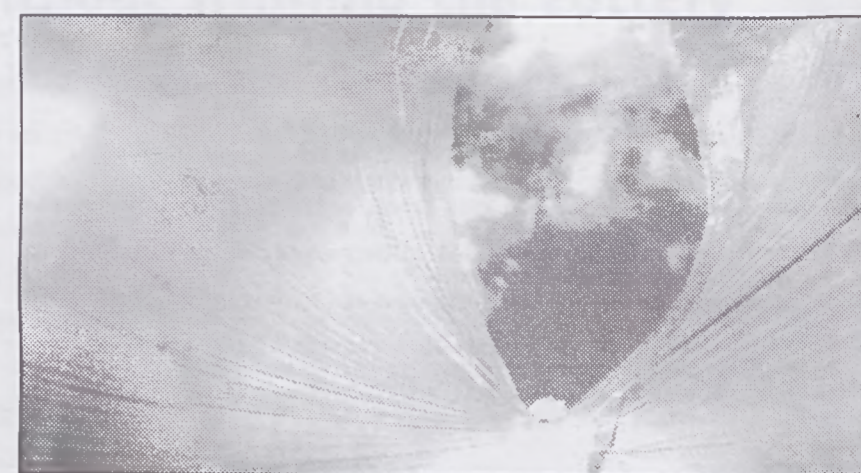

Community Open House Saturday, March 1

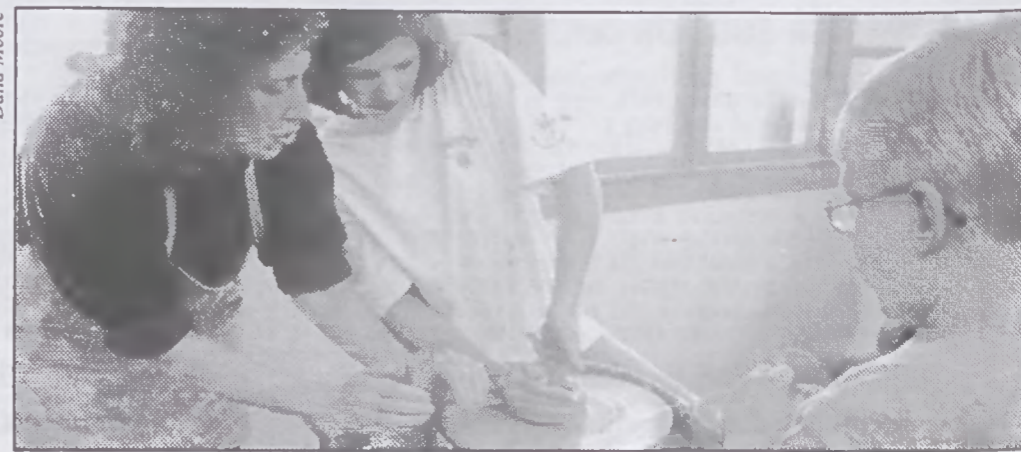
