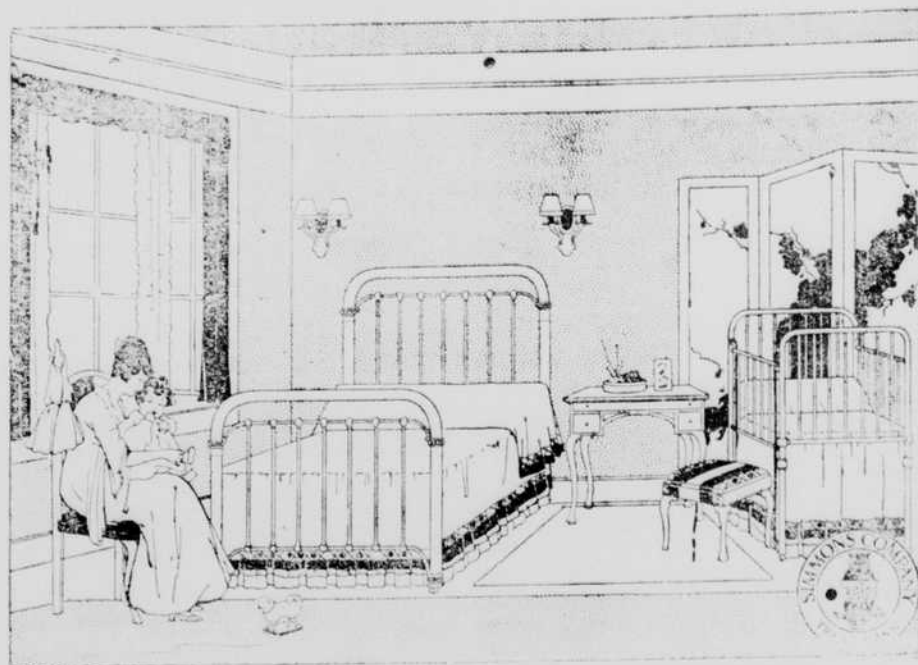

Trustee's Sale of Land.

AN ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Issuance of \$45,000 of Bonds of the Town of Weldon, North Carolina, for the Purpose of Enlarging the Town's Water Supply System.

Be it Ordained by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Weldon, North Carolina, as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the Municipal Finance Act, Chapter 3 of Chapter 56 of the Consolidated Statutes of North Carolina, as amended, bonds of the Town of Weldon, North Carolina, are hereby authorized to be issued in an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$45,000 for the purpose of extending and enlarging the water supply system in and for the Town of Weldon, at the expense of the Town at large.

SECTION 2. A tax sufficient to pay the principal and interest of said bonds shall be annually levied and collected.

SECTION 3. It is hereby determined, pursuant to the requirements of the Municipal Finance Act, 1921, that a statement of the debt of the Town of Weldon has been filed with the Town Clerk, and is open for public inspection.

SECTION 4. It is hereby determined that all expenses to be defrayed by means of the bonds hereby authorized are necessary expenses of the Town of Weldon within the meaning of Section 7 of Article VII of the Constitution of North Carolina.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be published once in each of two successive weeks after its final passage.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect thirty days after its first publication unless to the contrary a petition for its submission to the voters is filed under the Municipal Finance Act, 1921, and in such event it shall take effect when approved by the voters of the Town of Weldon at an election as provided in said act.

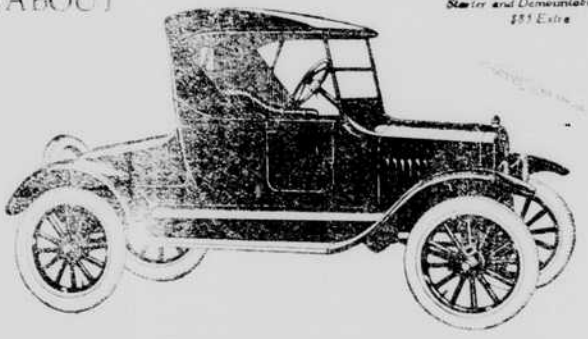
