PAYS BIG DIVIDEND

QUARTER OF MILLION DOLLAR INVESTMENT IN TUBERCULOSIS CHRISTMAS SEAS IN TEN YEARS PAYS DIVIDEND OF \$151,000.00.

The North Carolina Tuberculosis Association in seeking means to purchase our quota of fifteen million of the familiar penny stock, in honor of its campaign upon actual results measured in years of life and in dollars saved.

In the past eleven years the death rate from tuberculosis has been cut in half in North Carolina, which means in this State alone a saving of 35,000 lives and a money saving of \$11,000,000—a result attributed mainly to the campaign of education, prevention, and treatment financed largely by the Christmas Seal fund.

The North Carolina Association is the pioneer organization in preventing tuberculosis work in this State, and from the time of its reorganization in 1915 until this time has shown a steady growth in the scope of work done and the support given by the people. From a total Seal Sale of \$5,253.07 in 1918, donations increased to \$20,000.00 by 1923. For the year ending 1924 a total of \$250,100.00 has been invested in this work. Of this amount, \$128,996.83 has been retained by local chapters for use in the community in which it was raised. These funds have been used to purchase X-ray apparatus, to store to health and usefulness, they have provided medical and material relief when it was impossible for the patient to leave home. They have been used to employ public health nurses and nurses for the tuberculosis wards, where they have been to the schools and for educational work as to the nature, treatment, and prevention of tuberculosis.

During the past ten years the State Association has received from North Carolina a total of \$120,172.44. Of this amount \$18,231.51 has been sent to the National Tuberculosis Association for nation-wide work in the campaign against tuberculosis, and the State Association has used the balance for the following purposes:

Purchased X-ray laboratory at the State Sanatorium in order that accurate diagnosis could be made.

Purchased milk-bottling plant at the State Sanatorium.

Paid \$7,000.00 for the treatment of ex-servicemen before Uncle Sam was ready to grant them the pension.

Established tuberculosis clinics, where over 10,000 patients were examined.

Organized and sponsors the Modern Health Crusade in the schools of North Carolina.

Has been doing health educational work among the negroes for five years.

Conducts a campaign of health education throughout the State.

Established public health nurses in North Carolina.

Holds annual conference on tuberculosis.

Organizes county tuberculosis associations and creates active interest in construction of county tuberculosis sanatoriums.

Every dollar invested in this work in North Carolina has a dividend of \$300.00 to the State.
