

# THERE ARE SEVEN HUNDRED MILLION CHRISTIANS IN THE WORLD TODAY

## PICK AND SHOVEL BRING TESTIMONY

Archaeologists, excavating in Eastern lands, have added greatly to our knowledge of people and customs of Bible lands. They have also brought scientific proof of the accuracy of Bible stories.

Inscriptions have been unearthed of Rameses II, the king who "knew not Joseph." The inscriptions give the king's own account of the great buildings on which the Hebrews were compelled to labor. In some places bricks have been found made "without straw."

Dr. Wooley's expedition, while excavating at Ur, unearthed remains of a civilization six thousand years old. This was buried under eight feet of clean, white clay which, in turn, was hidden beneath a buried city. Scientists are convinced that the clay was deposited upon the ancient cities by the great flood from which Noah and his family were saved.

Evidences have been found of the destruction of Jericho told of in the book of Joshua. The archaeological date corresponds to the time indicated in the Bible record.

Excavations in Jerusalem have disclosed signs of the destructions and rebuildings of the city that are described in the Bible. One writer says, "It is probable that we have there traces and remains of older and more numerous generations than in any other city under the sun."

Excavations have identified almost all the places mentioned in the story of Nehemiah's night ride about the city told in Nehemiah 2:12-15. The Valley Gate, the Dragon Gate, the Dun Gate, the Fountain Gate and the King's Pool have all been found.

Scholars are studying the important recent find in Egypt of the earliest known manuscript of the Greek Bible. Some of these manuscripts date back into the second century A.D. They include the four Gospels, eight books of the Old Testament and some of the Pauline Epistles.
