Also take an estimation of the canning that you expect to do this year of both fruits and 32.96 vegetables. This information compiled in advance will help both you and the Ration Board. Be prepared to can the berries when they are ready is only a good business policy. Fats for Defense--It seems that there has been some trouble with disposing of the fats that has been salvaged.
