State College Hints Farm Homemakers

Christmas for the children lies as much, or even more, in the anticipation and preparation as in the celebration of the day itself, so let them help you with the planning, baking and decorating. One of the pleasant duties is to plan and decorate the home. Wreaths for the windows and on the doors to welcome guests; graceful garlands offer the fireplace or on the banister in the hall; evergreen balls, table decorations, and informal banquets enriched by soft light add cheer that can be obtained in no other way.

All members of the family, both grown ups and children, can contribute to the decorations of the home. They can first plan the decorations and then spend several hours together making the pieces to be used.

Mount your Christmas tree on a firm base away from the fireplace and use approved lights in good repair.

Give your children toys suitable for their age. Give baby smooth, washable toys colored with non-poisonous paint and with no pin or button eyes to swallow.

Avoid smoking when wearing false whiskers or a flammable Santa Claus suit and use non-flammable Christmas tree decorations.

Dispose of tissue and other wrappings immediately. Avoid burning loose papers or excelsior in a fireplace.

Peanut Clusters: Mix together 1-2 cup dark corn sirup, 1-4 cup molasses 1-3 teaspoon salt, and 1 tablespoon vinegar. Cook to 240 degrees or until a small quantity in water forms a soft ball. Add 2 tablespoons table fat; pour 2 1-2 cups shelled roasted peanuts. Mix quickly. Drop by tablespoons on greased surface. Makes 20 clusters.
