
Father Callahan is considered one of the outstanding speakers of the Church. Before a Georgetown graduation group recently, he said, "Almost everyone intends to take life seriously, but too often this resolve degenerates into a case of self-delusion. Many who think they are taking life seriously are only taking themselves seriously. Who takes himself seriously is over-conscious of his rights; who take life seriously is fully conscious of his obligation."

Father Callahan will assist in the Tenebrae services at the Cathedral in Raleigh on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday evenings. He will also speak before the North Carolina Catholic Laymen's Association groups in Greensboro on Easter Monday and in Goldsboro on the Wednesday after Easter.
