## Vatican Workers Get Pay Boost

VATICAN CITY — (NC) — All Vatican employees have received substantial raises in pay through the initiative of His Holiness Pope John XXIII.

The new pay scales, effective July 1, provide for an average increase of 25 per cent for employees of the various categories within the State of Vatican City. At the same time, increases in family allowances have doubled earnings for many workers.

Since the beginning of his pontificate Pope John has made a habit during walks in the Vatican to ask employees about their needs and those of their families. The Pope ordered His Eminence Domenico Cardinal Tardini, Vatican Secretary of State, to study the problem of wage raises. The pay boost announcement came as the result of months of personal work by the Cardinal.

Pope John recently told a group of Vatican employees: "Ours is not an industrial or commercial organization that must show a profit."

After the announcement of raises, many telegrams of thanks to the Pope from Vatican employee groups were received at the Secretariat of State and the Pope's office.

Before the raise, a typical worker in the Vatican Gardens might earn a base wage of 50,000 lire monthly (\$80), which is about standard for Italy. He would also receive 5,000 lire monthly for his wife, and 5,000 for each child.

Now the base wage has been raised to 70,000 lire (\$113), plus 10,000 for his wife and each dependent parent, and 12,500 for each child.

One Vatican employee, Luigi Mennini, has 14 children.

The Pope ordered an automatic raise of 3,000 to 5,000 lire monthly at the end of every two years of service. Previously wages were increased 5,000 lire every five years.

In addition, all Vatican employees have been made eligible to receive pensions. Formerly very few could look forward to such pensions.

It is recalled that the late Pope Pius XII expressed his intention last summer to raise wages.
